CODE OF CONDUCT

You must abide by the code of conduct at all times and represent yourself and the organization accordingly:

1. Respect your peers, volunteers and youth leadership and their opinions. Most importantly, **Respect Yourself!**
2. No Physical or verbal abuse of any kind will be tolerated.
3. The use of illegal substances and drinking alcohol is strictly prohibited. If you are caught with them, your parents will be notified.
4. Any type of weapon (guns, knives, etc.) is not permitted.
5. Any damage incurred to property or possessions not belonging to you will be paid for by the individual or individuals who cause the damage.
6. Youths must notify a Youth Leader of your whereabouts. No one is permitted to go anywhere without a Youth Leader's approval.
7. No one is permitted to get into a vehicle and travel anywhere with anyone other than an authorized individual.
8. Abide by all rules and regulations of the attended event, activity and/or project and participate to the best of their abilities.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Disciplinary action for infractions of this code of conduct may include any or all of the following:

Note: Any infractions of the code of conduct WILL result in involuntary Community Services (minimum of 4 hours).

- Extended one-on-one sessions with A.E.Y.L. leaders and/or parents to rectify areas of concern. These sessions are to be scheduled outside of regularly scheduled mentoring sessions.
- Self-accountability compositions, not to exclude the requirement of publicly acknowledging conduct through verbal presentation at any given group mentoring session appointed by an authorizing party.
- Cancellation of participation in upcoming event, activity and/or project that is considered a privilege.
- Consultation with parent to ensure consequence is carried out at home as well as within the organization.

MEMBERSHIP DUES AGREEMENT

The purposes of monthly dues are to provide funding for our organizational programs; academic materials, athletic activities and community service participation. One week following initial membership acceptance, you will begin paying monthly dues which are \$25 per member and \$15 additional for siblings.

Volunteer Release and Waiver of Liability Form

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "release") executed on (date) _____ by (name of volunteer candidate) _____ ("Volunteer") releases The Alliance of Elite Youth Leadership, ("Nonprofit") a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Texas and each of its directors, officers, employees, and agents. The Volunteer desires to provide volunteer services for Nonprofit and engage in activities related to serving as a volunteer.

Volunteer understands that the scope of Volunteer's relationship with Nonprofit is limited to a volunteer position and that no compensation is expected in return for services provided by Volunteer; that Nonprofit will not provide any benefits traditionally associated with employment to Volunteer; and that Volunteer is responsible for his/her own insurance coverage in the event of personal injury or illness as a result of Volunteer's services to Nonprofit.

Waiver and Release: I, the Volunteer, release and forever discharge and hold harmless Nonprofit and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from the services I provide to Nonprofit. I understand and acknowledge that this Release discharges Nonprofit from any liability or claim that I may have against Nonprofit with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from the services I provide to Nonprofit or occurring while I am providing volunteer services.

Insurance: Further I understand that Nonprofit does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide me with financial or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability benefits or insurance of any nature in the event of my injury, illness, death or damage to my property. I expressly waive any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of Nonprofit beyond what may be offered freely by Nonprofit in the event of such injury or medical expenses incurred by me.

Medical Treatment: I hereby Release and forever discharge Nonprofit from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during my tenure as a volunteer with Nonprofit.

Assumption of Risk: I understand that the services I provide to Nonprofit may include activities that may be hazardous to me. I hereby expressly assume the risk of injury or harm from these activities and Release Nonprofit from all liability for injury, illness, and death or property damage resulting from the services I provide as a volunteer or occurring while I am providing volunteer services.

Photographic Release: I grant and convey to Nonprofit all right, title, and interests in any and all photographs, images, video or audio recordings of me or my likeness or voice made by Nonprofit in connection with my providing volunteer services to Nonprofit.

Other: I expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. I agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Release shall not be affected.
